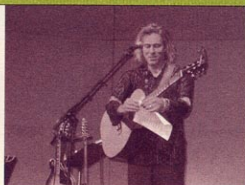




"Lonely Broccoli" sits atop Uncle Jim's head as he entertains the kids at the Key West Phest in Erie, PA on July 17, 2004.
